Spider-Man 3 will make its worldwide debut in Japan on May 1, three days before the action film premieres in North America on May 4, Sony Pictures Entertainment said. The star-studded premiere will be held at a Tokyo cinema on April 16. Those expected to attend include director Sam Raimi, series creator Stan Lee and stars Tobey Maguire and Kirsten Dunst. The film is slated for release in Singapore on May 3. -- AP
