We have strengthened our partnerships with other leading women's organizations such as SCWO, UNIFEM, AWARE and AWDS.

We have initiated and maintained strong working ties through mentoring, bursaries and scholarships with Ngee Ann Polytechnic and SMU. And tie-ups with INSEAD.

We helmed the FIT (Financial Intelligence Training) program to target wider Singaporean society and middle/lower income women to help them better plan their finances.

We raised more than S\$200,000 for women shelters in Cambodia together with UNIFEM at SNOW 2007.

Our frequent brownbags have attracted a strong following regularly hitting the maximum attendance of 40pax every time. In 2007, we had brownbags on Commodities, Asset Management, Hedge Funds, and Subprime in 2007 - each helmed by women experts in these fields.

Our Advisory Panel lunches are a landmark annual luncheon event where we have had the pleasure of hosting the best and brightest women in Singapore. We have added 2 more women to our advisory board in 2007: Ms Chua Geok Wah, accountant general of Singapore and Ms Rachel Farrell, MD of alternative investment products for Asia Pacific, Citibank. We now proudly have 6 wonderfully supportive advisors.

Our regular Up Close and Personal luncheons continue to be well received and attract new members. We have had many industry experts come speak to us sharing on a personal level.

Our FWAS newsletter has enabled us to keep in touch with our growing membership.

Through all these initiatives and the exco's commitment to FWAS' mission statement, our new members have grown steadily in the past couple of years and we are averaging at least 5-10 new members every month. Our FWAS mailing list has now crossed 450 and is likely to reach 500 by year-end.

Along the way and over the years, committee members have become great friends, a constant source of support and anchors in volatile times.

So from my heart and on behalf of my committee, many thanks for your endless support and friendship.

I look forward to serving all of you as president for another year.
